- Ability to lead by example in dress, attitude, finances, and all things becoming of a Christian.
- Available to work extended hours, evenings, over weekends, public holidays, and on short notices.

- Develop and submit a yearly Youth ministry plan and budget proposal.
- Preach and teach on occasion by the request of the Lead Pastor.
